Dear Members, Ladies and Gentleman,

This Memo is issued to refresh your memory and point your attention once more to the major obligations of IDSF Members under the WADA **World Ant-Doping Code (WADC)** and the **IDSF Anti-Doping Code (ADC)**.

IDSF Member obligations under the Anti-Doping Codes

--- It's a condition of membership of IDSF that your policies, rules and programs are in compliance with the **Anti-Doping Codes**.

--- All Members of IDSF are obliged to enforce the **Code** within their own jurisdiction, as part of the terms of their membership in IDSF.

--- Each Member must inform its registered (member) dancers, trainers, adjudicators, officials and athlete support personnel (including medical and para-medical personnel) about the requirements of the **Anti-Doping Codes**, its participants by handing them out a copy of the **Anti-Doping Codes**;

--- It's a Members duty that all athletes, athlete support personnel, adjudicators and officials recognize en be bound by the **Anti-Doping Codes**. This means in practice that all mentioned persons are to be member of your Federation or member of one of your members.

--- Require from your athletes to be available for out-of-competition testing.

--- Organize, conduct and perform Anti-Doping controls in your national competitions and championships.

--- Provide information to IDSF about your Anti-Doping programs and testing.

--- Authorize and facilitate independent observers from WADA and IDSF.

--- Withhold any and all support and funding to athletes and members, participants that are not in compliance with the **Anti-Doping Codes**.

THE ANTI-DOPING DELEGATE

--- Any member that nominates a participant to any IDSF granted DanceSport competition is deemed to have recognized the Anti-Doping **Codes** (participant means any athlete, coach, trainer, official, medical- or para-medical, or any other person working with or treating athletes).

--- Members will only nominate participants (including adjudicators) to any IDSF granted DanceSport competition who have agreed to comply with all of the duties of the **Anti-Doping Codes** and who have signed the **Forms of Consent**. The organizers of such competitions must refuse the entrance of any competitor and adjudicator that has not completed and signed the **Forms of Consent**.

--- Every member shall inform the IDSF Anti-Doping Commission of the results of Anti-Doping controls carried out by that member as well as of the measurements taken by that member in the event of positive test results. The same applies about doping controls carried out by others than IDSF or that member, such as a national anti-doping administration or institution;
